**SENATE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS
2019-2020 RULES**

1. The quorum of the Committee shall be sixteen (16) members.
2. The Chairman shall determine which bills and resolutions are to be considered and the order in which said measures are considered.
3. The Chairman shall have the authority to refer bills and resolutions to Subcommittees for study. Such Subcommittees in turn shall have the authority to make recommendations on such measures to the full committee.
4. The Committee shall convene, recess, and adjourn upon the order of the Chairman.
5. Any member or members of the Committee who disagree with the majority report of the Committee shall be privileged to file a minority report.
6. These rules may be amended upon a motion duly made and subsequently approved by two-thirds of the members of the Committee.
7. A bill, resolution, or other matter will be considered only after presentation by its principal author or a legislator designated by the author.
8. During Committee meetings, committee members and those in the audience shall turn off or place in silent mode all cell phones, pages, and other similar devices.
9. The Rules of the Senate shall control in any case not provided for in these Committee rules.

MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS
Tuesday, February 19th, 2019

The Senate Committee on Appropriations met on Tuesday, February 19th, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. in Room 341, State Capitol. Members present and absent are listed on the attached Roll Call sheet.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jack Hill (4th), at 8:01 am.

The first order of business was adopting the Committee Rules for the 2019-2020 term. Sen. Mullis (53rd) made a motion to adopt the Committee Rules, and Sen. Seay (34th) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. A copy of the Rules is attached.

SB 67 (Sen. Dean Burke, 11th, LC 33 7649) Capital Outlay Funds; eligibility for regular funding, advance funding for educational facilities; destroyed by fire or natural disaster
Senator Burke (11th) presented SB 67 to the committee by providing a brief background on the bill.

Sen. Mullis (53rd) made a motion **SB 67 Do Pass (LC 33 7649)**. Sen. Unterman (45th) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

HB 30 (Rep. Ralston, 7th) Supplemental appropriations; State Fiscal Year July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019

HB 31 (Rep. David Ralston, 7th) General Appropriations; State Fiscal Year July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020

Sen. Hill (4th) presented HB 31 to the Committee by providing a brief background on the bill.

Sen. Tillery (19th) made a motion **HB 31 Do Pass**. Sen. Albers (56th) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Sen. Jack Hill (4th) was be the Senate sponsor.

Committee Recommendation: HB 31 DO PASS BY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

HR 164 (Rep. Powell, 171st, LC 43 1024) Dedication of revenues derived from fees or taxes to the public purpose for which such fees or taxes were imposed

Rep. Powell (171st) presented HR 164 to the committee.

Sen. Hill (4th) presented a committee substitute (LC 28 9341S).

Sen. Tillery (19th) offered an amendment, which would make one change to the ballot language to specify that the funds to be dedicated would be “derived from fees on hazardous wastes, solid wastes, including fees related to the disposal of scrap tires,” mirroring other portions of the substitute.

Sen. Tilley (19th) made a motion to adopt his proposed amendment. Senator Gooch (51st) seconded the motion. The motion passed (19-1).

Sen. Tillery (19th) made a motion **HR 164 Do Pass by Committee Substitute (LC 34 5570S)**. Sen Gooch (51st) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Sen. William Ligon (3rd) was the Senate Sponsor.

Committee Recommendation: HR 164 DO PASS BY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE (LC 34 5570S)
