**AGENDA:**

- HB 65 – LC 40 1179S - Caldwell, 20th :** Requires local school boards to hold at least two meetings on the proposed budget, post details online and make available upon request.
- HB 614 – LC 33 6589S - Stovall, 74th:** Authorizes DOE to provide for the placement of video monitoring cameras and equipment by a school in self-contained classrooms in which students receive special education services.
- HB 659 - LC (sub expected) – Belton, 112th:** Requires publication of financial information on schools and school systems...
- HB 739 – LC 33 6430S - Tanner, 9th:** Revises and adds requirements for the process of adopting and examining instructional materials and content at the state and local level.
- HB 879 – HB 879/FA - Taylor, 79th:** Provides for the issuance of a seal of bi-literacy for high school graduates who have achieved a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing one or more languages in addition to English
- HB 895 – LC 33 6565S – Mayo, 84th:** Requires charter school board members to undergo training in sound fiscal management. Establishes a charter schools financial management certification program. Prohibits certain charter school personnel from serving simultaneously as CFO.
- HR 394 – LC 33 6324S - Nix, 69th:** Proposes an amendment to the Georgia Constitution; relating to the net proceeds of educational sales tax (E-SPLOST) and providing that it is distributed effectively.

**Hearing Only:**

**HB 959 – LC 33 6515S - Beskin, 54th:** Updates and clarifies certain provisions relating to conflicts of interest of local board of education members, end-of-course assessments, data sharing, and nonprofits established by the Office of Student Achievement.
