HR 394 – LC 33 6039S - Nix, 69th: Proposes an amendment to the Georgia Constitution; relating to the net proceeds of educational sales tax (E-SPLOST) and providing that it is distributed effectively.

HB 879 – HB 879/FA -Taylor, 79th: Provides for the issuance of a seal of bi-literacy for high school graduates who have achieved a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing one or more languages in addition to English

HB 870 – LC 33 6375 - Strickland, 111th: Prohibits high schools that receive state funding from participating in interscholastic athletic events by an athletic association which: (1) prohibits religious expression of student athletes; (2) prohibits its member schools from organizing and playing scrimmage matches, games, or other athletic competitions with nonmember schools.

HB 895 – LC 33 6565S – Mayo, 84th: Requires charter school board members to undergo training in sound fiscal management. Establishes a charter schools financial management certification program. Prohibits certain charter school personnel from serving simultaneously as CFO.

HB 868 – LC 40 1011 - Rogers, 10th: Eliminates the Georgia State Games Commission.

HB 959 – LC 33 6515S - Beskin, 54th: Updates and clarifies certain provisions relating to conflicts of interest of local board of education members, end-of-course assessments, data sharing, and nonprofits established by the Office of Student Achievement.
