- **SB 95 (Millar, 40<sup>th</sup>):** To provide that, in counties that utilize a chief executive officer/county commission form of government, all elections for the chief executive officer shall be conducted on a nonpartisan basis
- **SB 102 (Ginn, 47<sup>th</sup>):** To require the notation of ineligibility to vote on driver's licenses
