







# 2014 Fingerprint Submissions Processed

# CCH Database Statistics

- **3,934,306** Individuals
- **12,432,615** Arrests
  - 3,689,969 Felony Arrests
  - 6,193,343 Misdemeanor Arrests
  - 2,549,303 Unknown Severity
- **3,372,638** Arrests over 1 Year w/o Disposition
  - 954,285 Felony Arrests
  - 1,585,468 Misdemeanor Arrests
  - 832,885 Unknown Severity

# CCH Record Restrictions

- 2012 - House Bill 1176
- Modified O.C.G.A. §35-3-37
- Affected the dissemination of information for employment and licensing decisions.
- July 1, 2013 – System Changes Implemented



# Restriction Types

- **Time Expired Restriction**  
System Generated
  - **Statute Defined**  
Manual Entry
  - **Petition**  
Manual Entry

# Time Expired Restriction

*Restriction occurs when no disposition is entered in the required time frame.*

- **Two (2) years for a Misdemeanor**
- **Four (4) years for a Felony**
- **Seven (7) years for Unknown Severity**
- **Seven (7) years for Serious Violent/Sexual Felonies**
  - Murder
  - Kidnapping
  - Armed Robbery
  - Human Trafficking
  - Cruelty to Children
  - Rape
  - Aggravated Sodomy
  - Incest
  - Aggravated Sexual Battery
  - Statutory Rape
  - Aggravated Child Molestation
  - Enticing a Child for Indecent Purposes

# Time Expired Restriction

- July 1, 2013  
**5,436,651** arrest charges received a Time Expired Restriction.
- Approximately 18.9 million charges were on the database at the time this restriction was implemented.

# Time Expired Restriction

- Since July 1, 2013 **319,972** more records have been automatically restricted due to time and no disposition on file.
- As of September 12, 2014 **5,756,623** arrest charges have received a Time Expired Restriction disposition.


