- A focus on end-user systems such as records or case management systems (RMS/CMS)


# WHAT IS G-ISE?

- Statewide solution architecture providing a framework to meet GeorgiaJDX goals
- Vision and roadmap to support incremental GeorgiaJDX deployment
- Definition of the standards, functions and processes RMS and CMS systems must support to effectively participate in GeorgiaJDX information sharing
- Reflection of ongoing national standards initiatives:
  - Justice Reference Architecture (JRA)
  - Global Federated Identity and Privacy Management (GFIPM)
  - National Information Exchange Model (NIEM)


## G-ISE OBJECTIVES

- Provide a comprehensive, hi-level description of the GeorgiaJDX architecture
- Establish an architectural framework for implementing GeorgiaJDX capabilities
- Identify key architectural decisions that have been made or need to be made


# GEORGIAJDX STRATEGIC OVERVIEW




# G-ISE ARCHITECTURE FUNCTIONAL VIEW

## ANTICIPATED OUTCOMES

- Enable counties and circuits to re-use components such as the exchanges, services, and other infrastructure components,
- Allow for interoperability across multi-vendor products,
- Leverage funding in a manner that provides greater benefit to the community,
- Allow participants to leverage existing investments in technology,
- Reduce the cost of maintenance of separate interfaces since these will be standards based.

# ANTICIPATED PARTICIPANT BENEFITS

## Local Level

- Reduce redundant data entry
- Reduce delays in the flow of information between agencies
- Improve information available to agencies
- Improve staff productivity
- Reduce dependence on other stakeholder organization's response resources
- Reduce time locating information or data

## State Level

- Improve acquisition of data for policy and planning decisions
- Improve efficiencies in the administration of justice
- Improve public safety in Georgia
