HB 1 Representative Peake, 141st To change certain provisions relating to the use of marijuana for treatment of cancer and glaucoma, to provide for regulate medicinal use of cannabis and derivatives to treat certain conditions.

HB 177 Representative Wilkerson, 38th relating to child abuse and deprivation records, so as to provide that certain school personnel who are required to report child abuse shall be notified upon receipt of such report and upon completion of its investigation

HB 198 Representative Dempsey, 13th Relating to student health in elementary and secondary education, to require annual suicide prevention education training for certified school system personnel

HB 212 Representative Weldon, 3rd Relating to licensure requirements for pain management clinics, so as to revise a provision relating to the health care professionals who must be on-site at a pain management clinic in order for the clinic to provide medical treatment or services

HB 394 Representative Cooper, 43rd Relating to nurses, so as to revise various provisions relating to the licensure of registered professional nurses and licensed practical nurses

SR 84 Senator Burke, 11th RESOLUTION urging the Congress of the United States to enact significant reforms to the nation's federally financed graduate medical education programs and to provide states with additional resources to meet the health workforce needs of the future

SR 462 Senator Stone, 23rd RESOLUTION urging the Congress of the United States to amend the Controlled Substances Act of 1970 so as to authorize the study of medical marijuana
