**Updated Agenda:**

- SB 382 – Mullis, 53<sup>rd</sup> – Provide for the crime of retail theft.
- SB 383 – Davis, 22<sup>nd</sup> – Providing that items of value of the deceased shall not be converted to the coroner/medical examiner's personal use.
- SB 404 – Heath, 31<sup>st</sup> – Relating to issuance, expiration, and renewal of licenses to operate a motor vehicle, so as to remove evidence of approved deferred action status from the list of available documents for use in the issuance of a temporary driver's license or permit.
- SB 411 – Stone, 23<sup>rd</sup> – Relating to bonds and recognizances, so as to reduce the cash escrow account or other form of collateral required for professional bonding companies that have continuously operated for more than 12 months.
- SR 6 – McKoon, 29<sup>th</sup> – Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide for state-wide grand juries.
