The Senate Judiciary Non-Civil Committee will meet on Wednesday, March 5, 2014 at 3:00 p.m. in 307 CLOB.

Agenda:

- HB 60 – Rep. Holt, 112th – Relating to certain laws regarding carrying and possession by retired judges; provide exemption.
- HB 770 – Rep. Efstrotation, 104th – Creating the crime of home invasion.
- HB 773 – Rep. Dickey, 140th – Changing provisions relating to discharging a gun or pistol near a public highway or street.
- HB 838 – Rep. Tanner, 9th – Relating to invasion of privacy, so as to prohibit the transmission of photography or video depicting nudity or sexually explicit content under certain circumstances.
- HB 863 – Rep. Golick, 40th – Changing provisions relating to cruelty to animals and aggravated cruelty to animals.
- HB 911 – Rep. Ballinger, 23rd – Relating to assault and battery, so as to add provisions regarding strangulation as an aggravated assault.
- HB 985 – Rep. Kirby 114th – Changing provisions relating to filing false liens or encumbrances against public employees and expanding the protection against the filing of false liens to all citizens.
