The Senate Judiciary Committee meeting will be Monday, February 10, 2014 in 307 CLOB at 2:00pm.

Listed below are the bills that will be heard in the Senate Judiciary committee:

**SB 331 LC 21 2377– Harper, 7<sup>th</sup>** - Act to amend Code Section 15-6-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the number of superior court judges for each judicial circuit, so as to provide for an additional judge of the Waycross Judicial Circuit; to provide for the initial appointment of such judge by the Governor; to provide for the election and term of office of such judge; to provide for powers, duties, and responsibilities of such judge and the judges of such circuit....

**SB 340 LC 33 5266 - Stone, 23<sup>rd</sup>** - Act to amend the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, so as to revise, modernize, correct errors or omissions in, and reenact the statutory portion of said Code, as amended, in furtherance of the work of the Code Revision Commission; to repeal portions of said Code, or Acts in amendment thereof, which have become obsolete, have been declared to be unconstitutional, or have been preempted or superseded by subsequent laws....

**SR 808 LC 34 3977 – Williams, 19<sup>th</sup>** - RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to prohibit the application of foreign law in Georgia courts when such foreign law is in violation of rights guaranteed natural citizens by the United States and Georgia Constitutions; to prohibit the application of laws enacted by other states that violate the public policy of the State of Georgia.....

**HB 829 LC 29 5786 – Willard, 51<sup>st</sup>** - Act to amend Code Section 9-11-4.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to certified process servers, so as to change the sunset and legislative review provisions.....
