Listed below are the bills that will be in committee:

**HB 182 LC 29 (sub is coming) – Weldon, 3<sup>rd</sup>** – Relating to juvenile court administration, so as to delete provisions relative to a rehearing on the order of an associate juvenile court judge; to provide for the appointment of a judge pro tempore. ....

**HB 215 LC 29 5581S, Benton, 31<sup>st</sup>** - Act to amend Chapter 6 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to superior courts, so as to change provisions relating to filings in the clerk's office; to increase fees for certain filings; to change provisions relating to office hours....

**HB 382 LC 29 5677ERS, Powell, 171<sup>st</sup>** - Relating to general provisions for torts, so as to limit liability for a governing authority of a school that enters into a recreational joint-use agreement with a public or private entity; to provide for definitions; to provide for specifications for a recreational joint-use agreement; to provide for applicability; to provide an effective date.....

**HB 499 LC 29 5606S – Sheldon, 104<sup>th</sup>** - Act to amend Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions for torts, so as to provide that payor guidelines and criteria under federal law shall not establish a legal basis for negligence or a standard of care for medical malpractice....
