**SR 809** (Fort, 39<sup>th</sup>)

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to prohibit county and municipal governments from entering into contracts with private entities for the provision of parking enforcement services.

**SB 269** (Stone, 23<sup>rd</sup>) \***substitute**

Directs state agencies that provide funding to local governments to require local governments to certify that they are not enforcing any sanctuary policy as a condition of funding.

**SB 356** (Williams, 27<sup>th</sup>)

Relating to animals, so as to provide a definition of the term "owner"; to provide for impoundment of animals for any violation of Article 1 of Chapter 11 of said title.

**SB 378** (Millar, 40<sup>th</sup>) To amend an Act revising, superseding, and consolidating the laws relative to the governing authority of DeKalb County.
