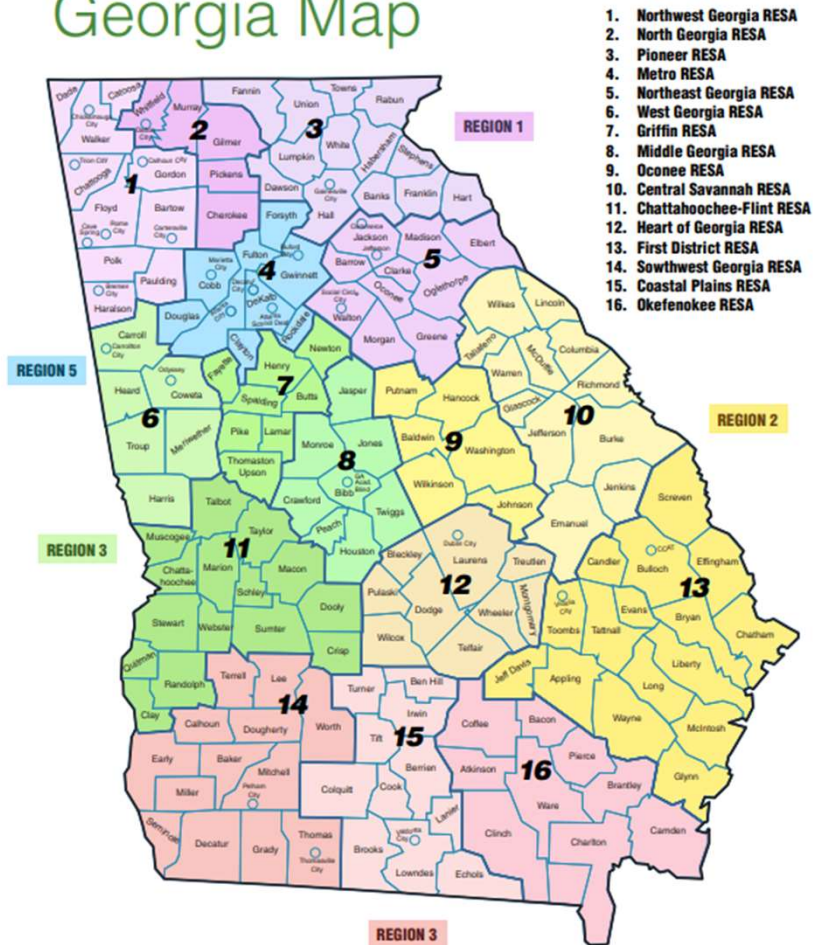
# HEALTHY, HUNGER FREE KIDS ACT – 2010

HEALTHY, HUNGER FREE KIDS ACT  
REQUIRES SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE MEALS  
TO CHILDREN THAT NORMALLY COULD NOT  
AFFORD THOSE NUTRITIOUS ITEMS.

- IN 1965, IT WAS REALIZED THAT A VAST MAJORITY OF SOLDIERS GOING OFF TO WAR WERE MALNOURISHED.
- IN 1969, THE PRESIDENT DECLARED MALNUTRITION A MATTER OF NATIONAL SECURITY.

# WHO DO WE SERVE

## For Georgia

- Pre-K → 46,504 students
- K – 5 → 745,800 students
- 6 – 9 → 557,849 students
- 10 – 12 → 372,974 students

From the above numbers, a total of 1,420,132 meals were served.

(These numbers are current as of March 4, 2021.)

# ACCESS TO NUTRITIOUS FOODS IN TIFT SCHOOLS

- Schools – 11
- Cafeterias – 11
- ADP (Average Daily Participation)
  - Breakfast
    - Georgia – 36.9% (approximately 507,669 meals)
    - Tift County – 50.3% (approximately 4,132 meals)
  - Lunch
    - Georgia – 64.8% (approximately 912,463 meals)
    - Tift County – 92% (approximately 7,580 meals)

**NOTE: The above numbers are from the 2020 fiscal year.**

## SNP SERVICES

- CEP (Community Eligibility Provision) – Allows schools and LEAs located in low-income areas to provide free breakfast and lunch to all students.
