**Senator Steve Henson** is a Democrat representing Senate District 41 since 2003 and formally represented Senate District 55 from 1991-1999.

Sen. Henson currently serves as the Minority Leader for the Senate Democratic Caucus and is the Vice Chairman of the Urban Affairs Committee. He also serves on the Administrative Affairs, Government Oversight, Health and Human Services, Natural Resources and the Environment, Reapportionment and Redistricting, Regulated Industries and Utilities and Rules committees.
