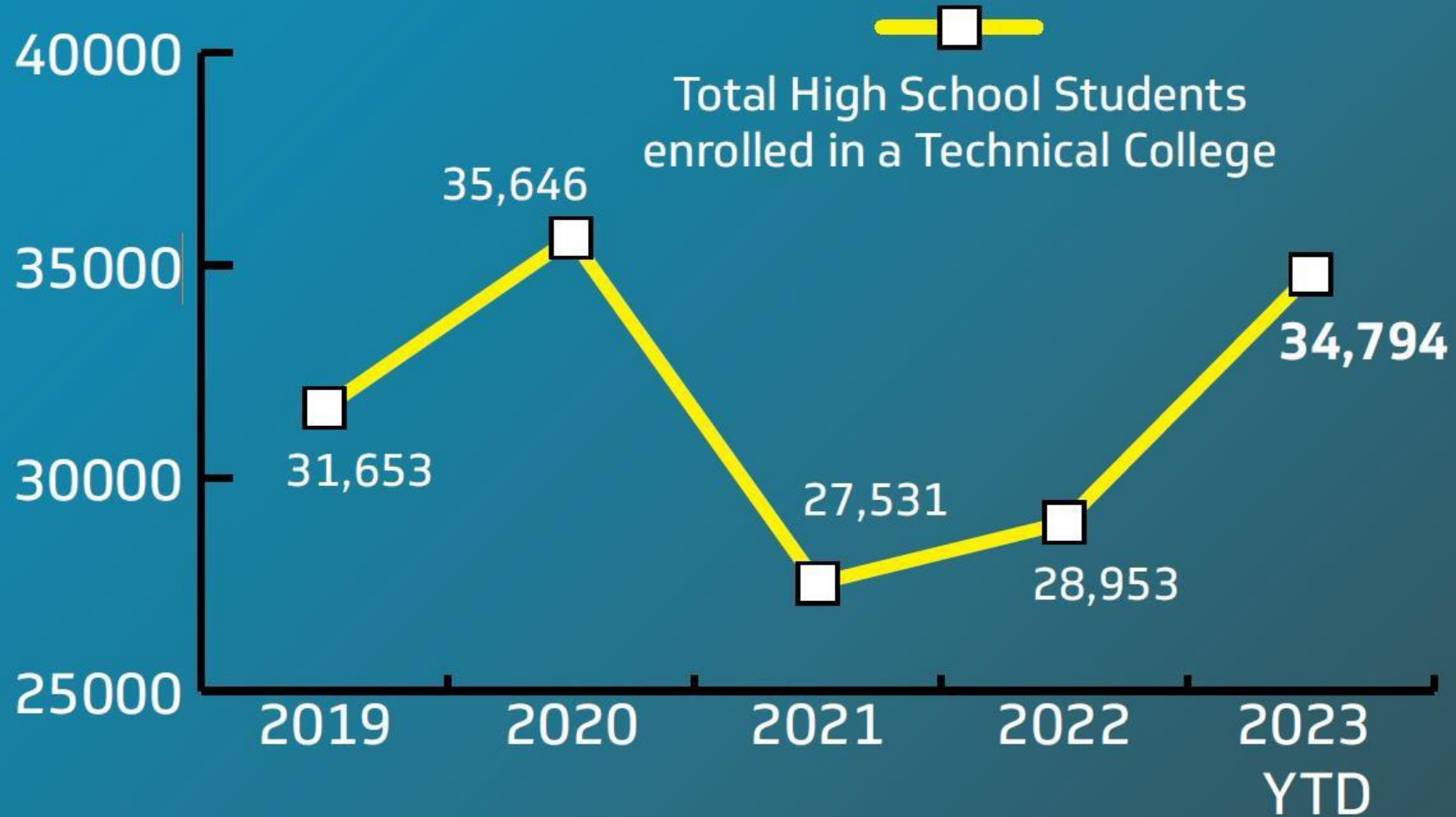
AY2023 Accelerated Career Statistics

- 526 High School Students enrolled in Academic Year 2023 statewide
- Programs with highest student enrollment:
 - Basic Shield Metal Arc Welder TCC
 - Welding and Joining Diploma
 - Automotive Electrical/Electronic Systems Tech TCC
- Programs with most awarded credentials:
 - Basic Shield Metal Arc Welder TCC
 - Gas Metal Arc Welder TCC
 - Automotive Electrical/Electronic Systems Tech TCC

Accelerated Career Graduates since FY2021

- 56% of Accelerated Career students continued their education exclusively after completion
- 44% of Accelerated Career students were employed after completion

TCSG Dual Enrollment Awards and Graduates

- AY 2021
 - 7,629 Unique Graduates
 - 11,396 Awards (TCCs, Diplomas and Associate's Degrees)
- AY 2022
 - 7,610 Unique Graduates
 - 11,513 Awards (TCCs, Diplomas and Associate's Degrees)
- AY 2023 (as of 9/11/2023)
 - 8,470 Unique Graduates
 - 12,459 Awards (TCCs, Diplomas and Associate's Degrees)

HOPE Career Grant Graduates

- AY 2021 – reported September 2022
 - 21,314 Graduates
 - 77% Employed post graduation
 - 21% Continued their education
- AY 2022 – as of September 11, 2023
 - 20,081 Graduates
 - 79% Employed post graduation
 - 17% Continued their education
