

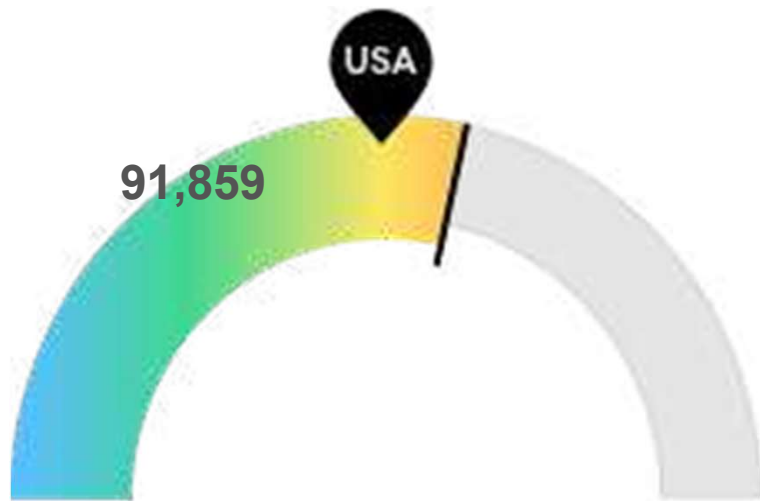

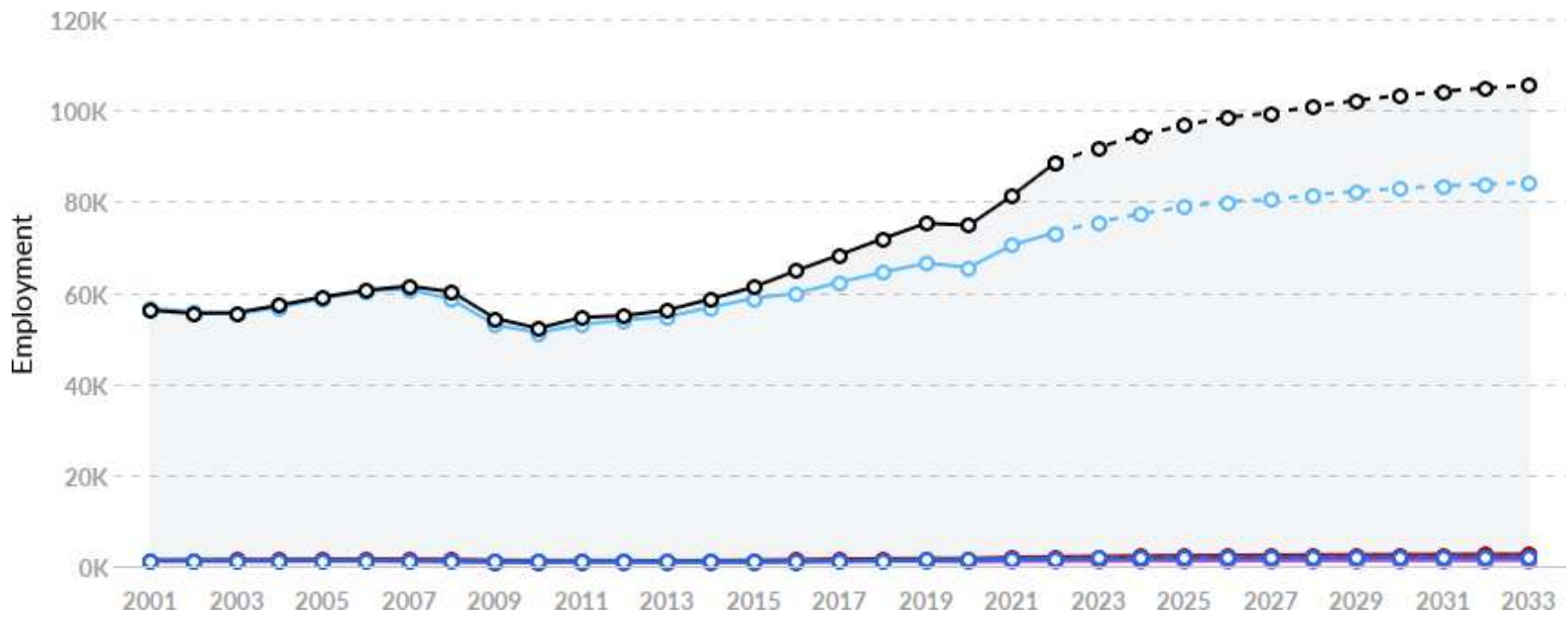
Statewide CDL Demand



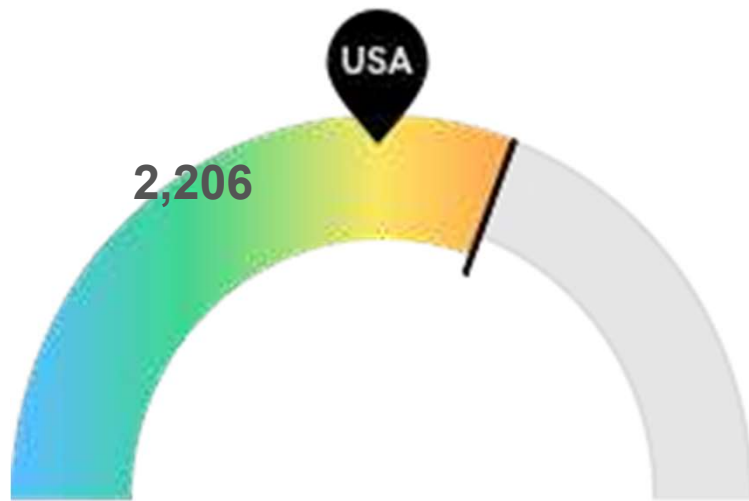
Jobs (2023)

The number of unique postings for this job from Jan 2023 to Aug 2023.



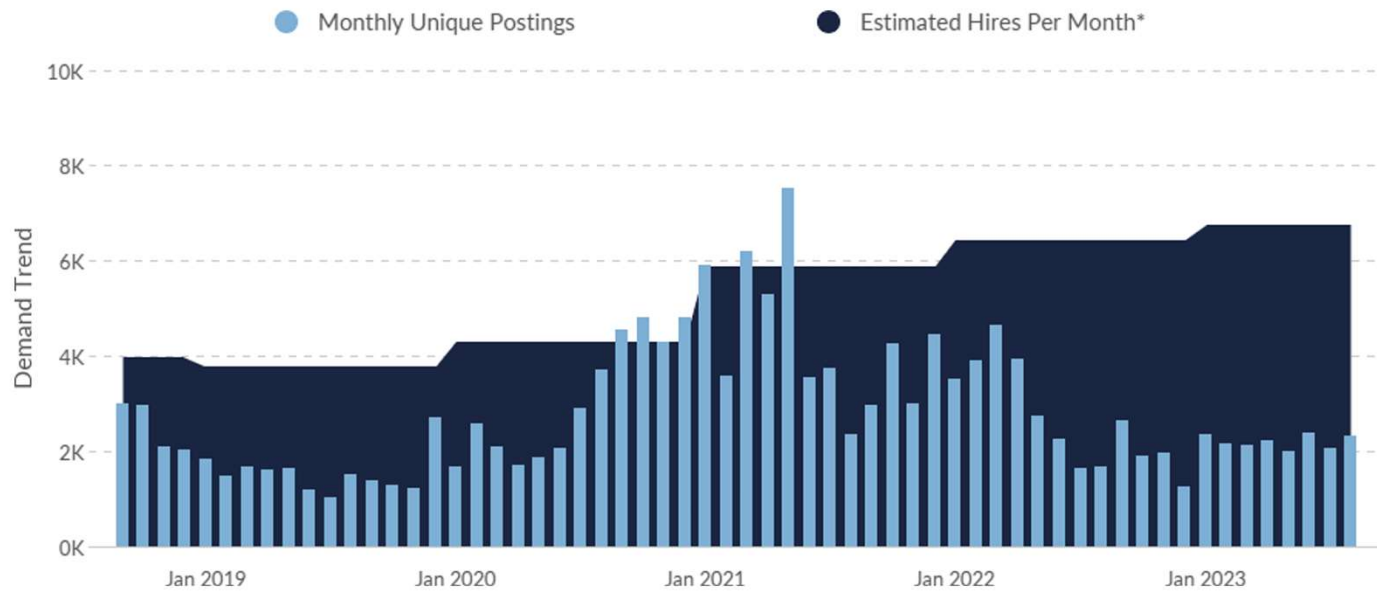

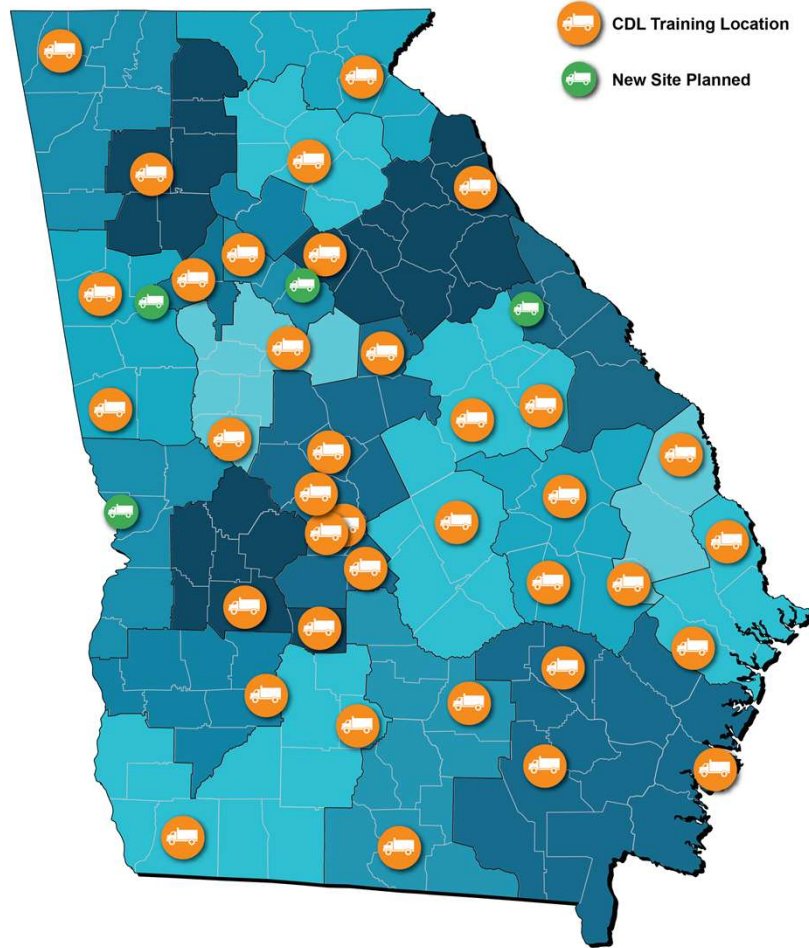
